Dr. Huisheng Xie DVM, PhDFounder and President of Chi University



Dr. Xie has 42 years of clinical, teaching, and research experience in veterinary acupuncture and TCVM. He has trained over 11,000 veterinarians to practice TCVM worldwide. Dr. Xie's education includes advanced training in veterinary medicine, veterinary acupuncture, and human acupuncture. Dr. Xie has authored 20 books and over 100 peer-reviewed papers. His textbooks, including *Xie's Veterinary Herbology, Xie's Veterinary Acupuncture*, and *Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine-Fundamental Principles*, have been used for TCVM training programs around the world. Dr. Xie continues to teach and develop educational courses and programs at Chi University, serves as a full clinical professor at the University of Florida's College of Veterinary Medicine, and is an honorary professor at China Agricultural University, South China Agricultural University, and China Southwest University.

Dr. Chrisman received her DVM from Michigan State University in 1968, an MS degree from the Ohio State University in 1974 and became certified in veterinary neurology by the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine in 1976. Dr. Chrisman is a certified veterinary acupuncturist from Chi. She was a professor and Chief of the Neurology Service at UF for 30 years and integrated acupuncture into her neurology practice as well as a member of the UF Acupuncture Service. She is a Professor Emeritus at UF as well as the former Editor-in-Chief of the American Journal of Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine and is on the Executive Board of the American Association of Traditional Chinese Veterinary Medicine.

Dr. Yael Avidan-Bali CVA, CVFT, CVCH, CCRT




Dr. Yael Avidan-Bali graduated from the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM) Veterinary School in 1992. Followed by a small animal ophthalmology internship at The Specialty Veterinary Hospital in Mexico City. She earned her certification in human acupuncture from Neijing School of Oriental Techniques in Cancun, Mexico in 2005. Later she earned her certification in veterinary acupuncture and food therapy from Chi University in 2010 as well as earning her certification in veterinary rehabilitation therapy (CCRT) from the Canine Rehabilitation Institute the same year. In 2015 she got certified by Institute Lineo in Madrid, Spain on Ozone therapy and in 2018 she earned her certification on herbal medicine from the Chi Institute. Dr. Bali moved with her husband and two children to Israel in 2011. Since then, she has had her own small animal, holistic veterinary medicine practice. She integrates Veterinary Acupuncture, Herbal Medicine, nutrition, rehabilitation and Ozone therapy into her practice.

Dr. Maya Barak received her DVM from Warsaw University of Life Sciences in Poland in March 2013. She earned her veterinary acupuncture certification for small animals and horses from Chi University-Florida USA in 2015. Dr. Barak is currently working towards her certification in TCVM Food Therapy (CVFT) from Chi University. Dr. Barak offers integrative clinical service for small animals in her clinic and also in shelter medicine. She integrates Veterinary Acupuncture, Herbal Medicine, nutrition, Network Chiropractic care and Ozone therapy into her practice.





CVA PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The course begins with an overview of fundamental aspects of Chinese Medicine, including *Yin-Yang* and Five Elements theory, which serve as a foundation for case diagnoses and treatment presented later in the class. A variety of acupuncture techniques are taught, including electro-acupuncture, aquaacupuncture, moxibustion, etc. in addition to conventional "dry" needling. In acupoint labs, students learn acupuncture points on live dogs.

The course is presented in 2 online sessions and 3 hybrid sessions. Each hybrid session includes two segments: online & on-site. Online segments are comprised of lectures and case demos that students can stream at their own convenience. On-site segments give students the opportunity to learn acupuncture points on live animals in small acupoint lab groups of four to six students per instructor. The on-site segment of this course is located in Israel.
